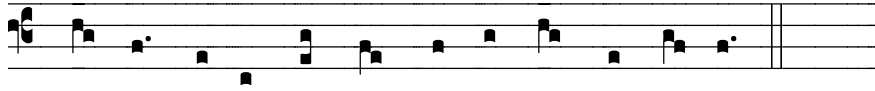

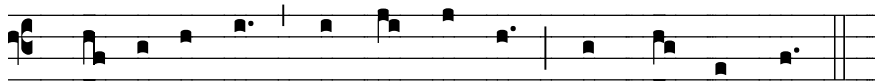

and bestowed on him the name which is above every name.

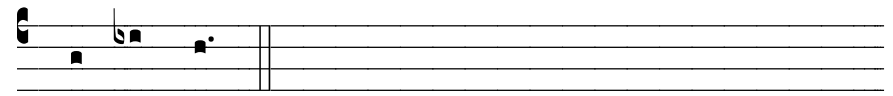
## VENERATION OF THE CROSS

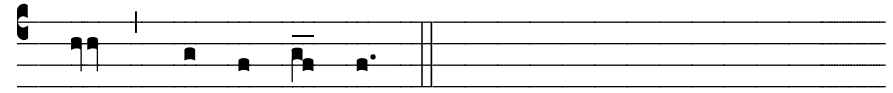

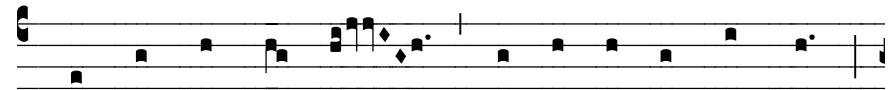

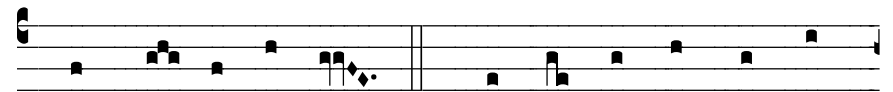
